What do people care and feel worry, feel challenges in their old city?

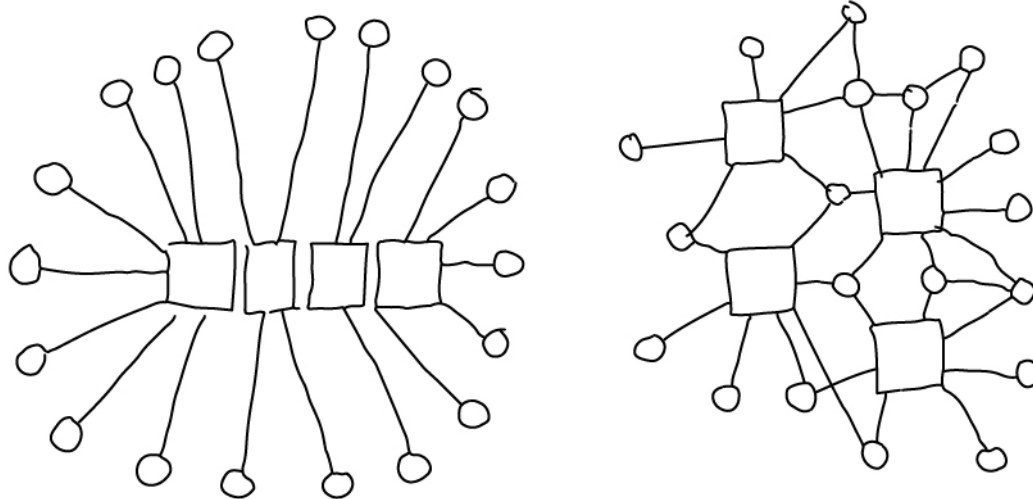
What kind of processes that people are doing and keep people together? And how can we strengthen it?

In Thailand

In 2003 when CODI start Baan Munkong [people’s housing program]
With the core ideas to create process that people can come together to build, to upgrade
their own communities.
To co-create communities unlock the old structure and culture that look down on human
capacity do organize themselves to the meaningful and communal way of living.

Now a day a program is still running and become new culture more than 100,000 houses
have been built and upgrade, and this idea are implement country-wide in 300 cities of
Thailand.

And Chumsaeng city is one of that.
Now CODI and communities network are trying to develop new program
To do inclusive city planning.
Chumsaeng is one of six pilot cities to start explore the process and elements to make this
program able possible.

We are right in the begging of this program and process.
It is not about how to co-create but it is about

why we are doing these?

6 water and agriculture

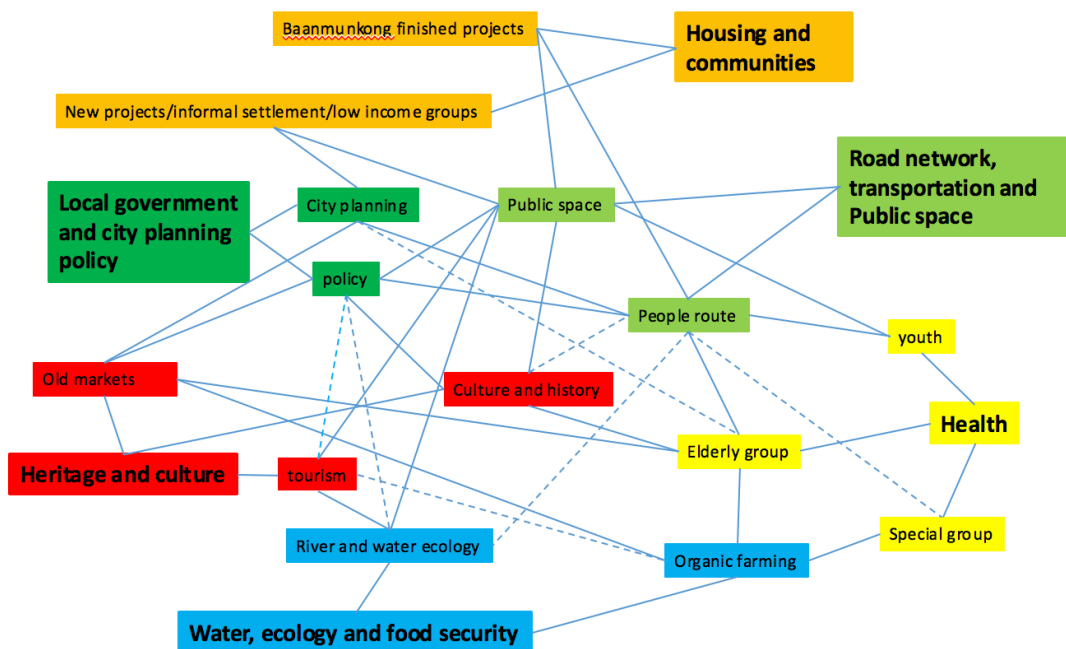
each group has its own issues to explore with local people that care and concern on that issue and every group share the common issue common questions.

You may feel it is too confusing and don't know how to do during the chaos situation in the workshop, it is ok because this process is also new to all of us as well.

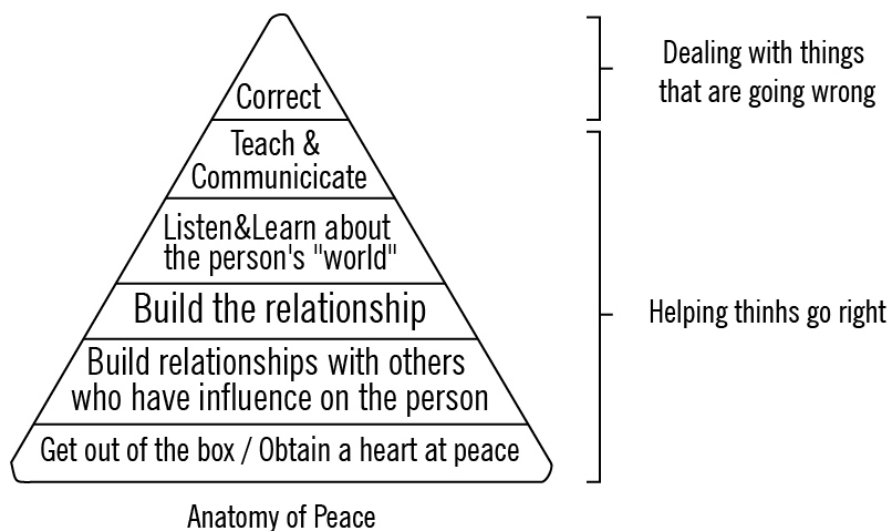
We don't have to know everything,

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CAN COCREATE - 4th CAN Regional Workshop, 2016 At Chumsang City of Nakornsawan Province, Thailand 14th - 21st July 2016

Workshop's Concept

COMMUNITY ARCHITECTS NETWORK (CAN) is a regional network of community architects and planners, engineers, young professionals, lecturers and academic institutes in Asian countries. Established in 2010, the network has been supporting community-driven projects regarding people housing, citywide upgrading, and recovery from disasters. We believe the role of community architects is to build the capacity of people, by participatory design and planning process to make people be their own solution. Since 2010 as the networking started, there are 15 groups of professional in 12 Asian countries involving by working on participatory design and planning, city-wide mapping and surveys, seeking design solution to improve quality of life and health of community, as well as training community builders through 80 workshops in 50 cities where 120 communities has benefited by its outcome. Each workshop usually participated by community's network, NGO, architect, planner, and students plus civic groups and local authorities. Since 2010 there are more than 2,000 peoples involved.

Every 2 years, Regional CAN workshop will be organized to be a platform of mutual learning and working together in selected city. This is the 4th CAN Regional Workshop that will held at Chumsang City, Thailand under the concept of **"CAN COCREATE"**.

"CAN COCREATION" is the process of co-creating and design between man and nature with profound understanding and respectful. It is a key stones for sustainable development that reflecting on community and city planning in practice concerning participation, regenerative and rehabilitate of the abundance of nature and people culture.

The 4th CAN Regional Workshop will be held at Chumsang City, a small city of Nakornsawan Province located on fertile basin of Choa Phra Ya River. Chumsang City can be the representative of any small cities in Asia that facing development pressures like insecure housing, unplanned city, losing heritage, pressure of urbanization over the agriculture land, and flooding from the climate change. This workshop will be participated by community architect and professionals from 15 Asian countries together with community people and network in Chumsang, in total there are around 100 participants.

This workshop co-hosted by Asian Coalition for Housing Rights (ACHR), Community Organization Development Institute (CODI), The Association of Siamese Architects under Royal Patronage (ASA), Community Acts Netowork (CAN- Thailand), Phranakhon Rajabhat University, civic group called "Chumsang my beloved" and Chumsang Municipality.

Objective

1. To exchange experiences of professional architects/planner/lecturers who has been wide range of experiences working in Asian community/city development
2. To be the constructive platform that influence the community and city development in which emphasis on the dignity of man and nature
3. To conduct the fieldwork and catalyst process with municipality and people alliance of Chumsang City on city planning and her development's issues
4. To be the platform of sharing and exchange on architectural and planning's pedagogy among lecturers in Asia.

Expected Outcome

1. There will be the constructive exchange and mutual gaining between architect and professional regarding community and city planning by way of working together in the field
2. There will be active partnership among architectural universities in Asia on participatory design in community and city development/planning
3. There will be common space of working in partnership among Chumsang's Municipality, people alliance of Chumsang City, and professionals to explore the new possibility of sustainable city where economic, culture, and environment can go hand in hand
4. The concept of participatory design and planning (co-create) will be a common understanding among universities, professional, community's network in Thailand and Asia
5. There will be the video to collect and share the collective experiences of this workshop to wider audiences
